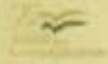

NOTES

During the visit to the various wards of Panchayat Balga Mugam. It was observed that internal link road are not upgraded yet and are promising a shabby look. ~~BHS Dardpara~~ BHS Dardpara and GMS Mugam are without fencing and at present trespassing is a common affair. Also the main department like Health centre and Animal husbandry centre are functioning in rented dilapidated building. The overall scenario of electricity supply is very worst. Further there is need of Augmentation of existing water supply facilities so that uninterrupted & potable water is ensured to every house holder. Also Trust is reqd to bring dropped beneficiary under PMAY scheme.

Suggestion :-

1. It is suggested that some internal road shall be handed over to R & B department so that maladiminzation work is carried out.
2. Fencing shall be provided to both school i.e BHS Dardpara and GMS Mugam and also separate additional block may be approved for BHS Dardpara.
3. Separate building shall be approved for health centre mugam and Animal husbandry unit with all modern equipments and medicine so that people get benefit at door step.
4. Balance electric pole shall be installed immediately and electric supply be provided uninterruptedly and pole be provided to ward. 3.
5. ²⁶ R & B Dept. shall be made accountable as to why not till date the road from General road to Diver via Balvath is not upgraded yet.
6. ~~Revenue~~ ^{Revenue} department shall be made accountable as to why not demarcation is carried out till date for construction of road from Km 9th to Peer Mohalla mugam.
