



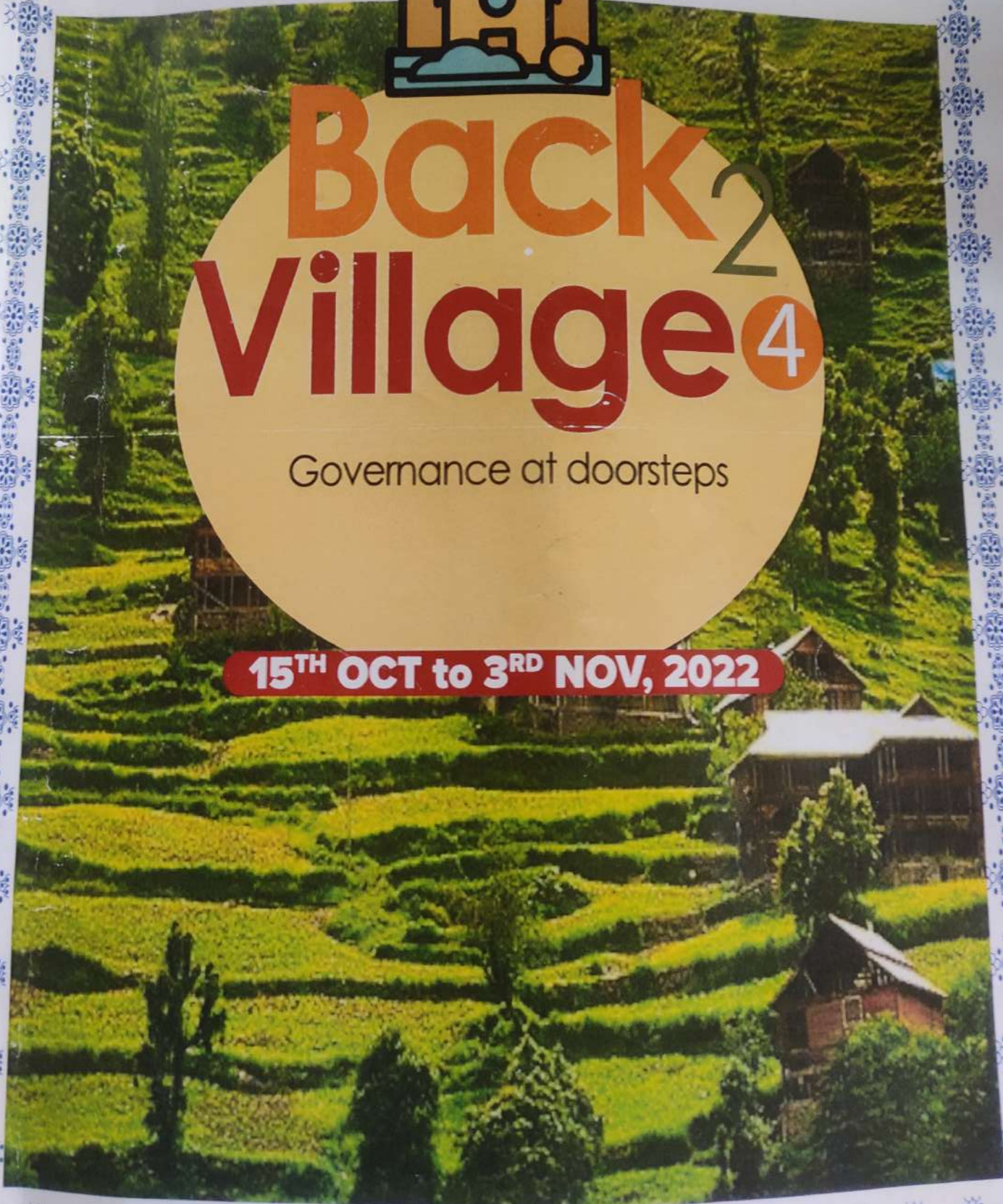

4. The Govt. Middle School Wahipore is running in a three roomed building which have been constructed by the Block in 1965 and is totally unsafe and damaged. The Roll of the school is near about 80 and the space for the students and Tis, is insufficient which may cause a drop out rate of the students. The Gen. Public and P.R.s have provided a plot of land six Kanals to the Govt for construction of new Middle School building for the whole school and also, the school to be got shifted to this new sports ground (Place). The area is very much populated and roll of students is near about 1500 who are getting edu. in both Pvt. and Govt. Schools.
