



OVERALL ASSESMENT OF PANCHAYAT.

- There is visible work done on ground by the line functionaries in the panchayat.
- The panchayat is well-connected with pucca roads & lanes.
- Solar lights have been installed in the panchayat & solar panel in panchayat ghar. Moreover, there is sufficient use of bio-gas unit in the panchayat promoting clean & green energy use.
- Problem of shortage of water has been largely resolved under JJM.
- Area of concern: The only existing school in the Panchayat is the Middle School which requires urgent attention. There are only six desk for 74 students in the school, there is no proper water/sanitation facility in the school. The undersigned contacted PHE Deptt. & arranged for water tanks on the spot and also contacted concerned CEO who immediately sent the concerned ZEO & has assured for providing required infrastructure (desks in first instance) within 15 days.

* The villagers have time & again iterated the ill-affects & hazardous of industries established in the panchayat. There are presently two industries operational in the closed vicinity of panchayat ie Cement Manufacturing Unit & Pesticide Manufacturing Unit.

Department of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj

The industries have caused grave damage to the crops & vegetation in the panchayat.

The pollution arising from these factories has also affected the health of the residents of the panchayat. Moreover, as submitted by the panchayat, the labour/workers of these factories are not having proper sanitation facilities in the factories & thus are defecating in open fields. The water wastage of these industries is being let in open drains thus polluting the water resources of the panchayat.

The worst performing department as per Panchayat is Revenue Deptt. out of 2100 land pass books, only 100 has been digitised so far by the deptt. Moreover the concerned Patwari has shown reluctance in starting in panchayat ghar due to non-availability of bathroom, which is under construction & shall be completed within a week's time as reported by the Sarpanch. People in general face difficulties in getting their work done through Revenue.




