After performing the scheduled activities during the two day programme of Back To Village-4 on 28th & 29th of October 2022, I am summarizing the overall assessment under the following points:

- In the interior of chatosa, they need repairment of LT electricity lines.
- Inside the village the link roads need repairment and also people demanded the construction ~~clafis~~ bunds at many places in Tangmulla.
- There is dire need of Assistance to the people who are very poor & downtrodden, living in Tin Sheds especially in the Tangmulla (Khan Mohalla). They need to be covered under AAY on priority.
- People need awareness programmes about various schemes as they don't know what to do, where to go or how to fulfill the pre-requisites for any particular scheme.
