GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall inform himself/herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in recording issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village developmental plan, he has to ensure that demands are prioritized and decided under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative department under JCS/JUT plans under supervision to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for collection is under district/CSS plans.
4. His work shall be having one planning and audit and is not a RA exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one MDO official (village Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant documents in hand, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the report at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.




