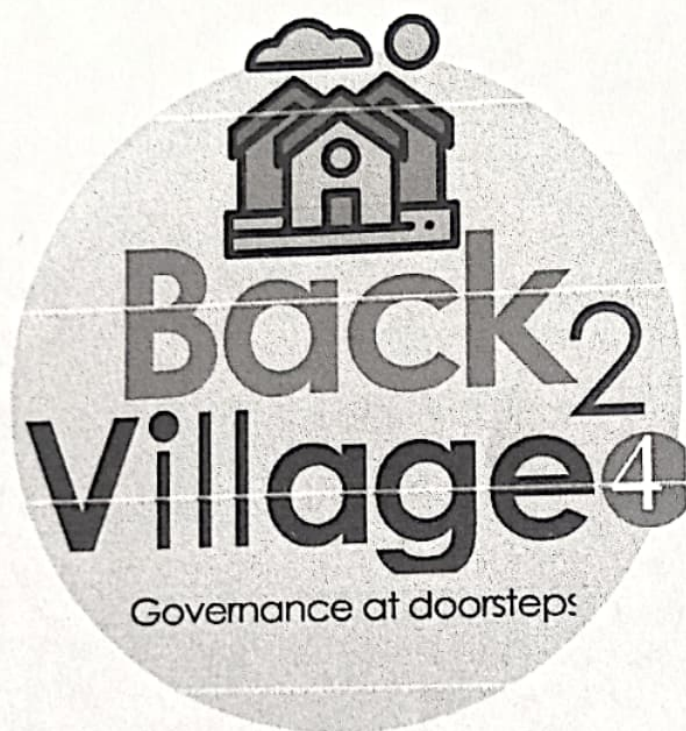

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER

- I Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
A big chunk of Bardulla village is not covered under the water supply scheme that will suffice for them in the winter as well. The area doesn't have good transport connectivity. Area demands ATM facility & renovation of panchayat ghar and school buildings.
- II Major/urgent public demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
 1. To merge pyt. Halqa Barsoo with Lar block.
To cater the problem of Drinking water scarcity of the bardulla village during winter season.
 2. Bank Business unit and ATM
- III Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions:
The major chunk of the population, which have had horizontal and vertical migration lack proper drinking water facility. Moreover the villages are not connected to the main traffic routes because of the unavailability of the transport. The electric poles are not installed in every nook and corner and the electric lines still run through bushy trees, posing threat to the human life.
A new water supply schemes (annexed in GPDP), maintenance and extension of the old water supply scheme are a priority to reach out to the common masses.
Erection of new poles & wiring electricity.
Bank branch should be started in the midst of the panchayat with ATM as well.
Renovation of panchayat Ghar and furniture for it is must.
