In the gram sabh held in the evening on day first of B. V. 10: 29-10-22, different demands were raised by the participants. A patient hearing was given to all of them and their demands which are not highlighted in the plan are as under:

1. Construction of Road from old Masjid Sheheenpore to Shehmohla via Baghi Islam by way of earth filling and cutting with R/W and B/W. Length almost 1.5 km. R & B deptt. may be asked for tendering this work.
2. PHE-department related demand: 3" dia pipeline from St Kuliwari to Sheheenpore, length about 1 km with distribution 1", 1.5" G.I pipes.
3. Construction of road from Phe-Lihom road to Shehmohla estimated length almost 500 m.
4. Construction of Road from Baghi Islam to Andaspora via Khan Mohla length almost 1 km. (R and B deptt.)
5. Lining wall of Lacham kaul from Shehmohla to H. and. Demarcation of the kaul may be done by Revenue deptt.
6. PDD related demand L.T line poles 40 and H.T poles 20
7. PDD L.T poles 25 @ for Andaspora, a hamlet of Panche yet Ville and transformer 250 KV.
8. R and B: Construction of Road from Shehmohla to Gund via Aboul.
9. Construction of drain and filling from spring of Sheheenpore to UPS school length 300 feet.
10. Construction of Bore Well near masjid sheef Sheikh mohla.
11. Construction of Road from Sheheenpore to College via Markhee Doga by way of earthwork, with R. walls and culverts.
12. Construction of Road from Masjid sheef Baghi am to main road via Gulsten School.
