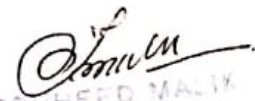

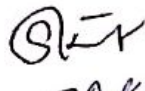
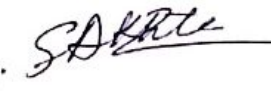
MAHILA SABHA .
