

- 1. That our school is located on a sloping piece of ground next to Shah Mohalla Hergam behind the village graveyard.
- 2. Because this school was built on a sloping piece of ground, its main entrance slopes for about 25 to 30 feet.
- 3. That walking on it is extremely challenging for everyone—teachers included—and even more so for pupils.
- 4. On wet days, it is hard for young pupils to go to school since the mentioned path is slick.
- 5. Due to the slick pathway, which makes it impossible for kids to walk on, about half of the pupils are missing these days.
- 6. Given that you are fully aware of the circumstances in government schools, this absence will have an impact on the students' academic performance as well as their career in the future.
- 7. Moreover the said school is unsafe without boundary wall as stray days are wandering in its yard every day which caused threat among the students.
- 8. Whereas we have several times knocked the door of concerned authority but no attention has been paid yet as we have already demanded in previous Back to Village Programme.

In light of the foregoing, we respectfully request that you please consider our demand regarding the construction of steps, tiled path and boundary wall for the aforementioned school so that students can attend class regularly without difficulty.
