Overall Assessment & Suggestions

There is very less mark of development in Panchayat Chayloo Bamihol. All departments seem to be at infant stage of development, especially PDD. The economic condition of the people is not so good, awareness among the people about Govt. Schemes is not upto the mark. The PRI members are active and the Panchayat has a lot of scope for development which needs to be exploited for overall development. All concerned departments need to provide basic amenities such as electricity (poles, wiring, transformer and supporting staff), water (filtration plant, reservoir and supporting staff) and footpaths, drainage, internal roads and wallah bunding being a flash flood prone area.
