Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions :-

The life of the villagers is improving with the digitalization of government schemes. People are taking the benefits of many schemes like; Ayushman Bharat, Old Age Pension, Widow Pension, Land Pass book etc. But some schemes are not saturated fully due to some changes in their rules as-

Kisan Credit Card (KCC) :- Due to non issuance of Noc by cooperative society to the villagers.

PM Kisan Sammannidhi :- Due to change in land verification rules

Ladlee Beti Scheme :- Due to the condition of income Certificate.

They required some basic amenities like safe drinking water throw tap, Blacktop of the road from Pindi Kathar to the Pindi Charkan, disposal of lane drainage water as it goes directly into their field and construction of road leading to cremation ground.
