

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise,
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
