Major Complaints & Grievances.

1. Restoration of water supply by enriching lift system or connecting to water resources available in Panchayat.
2. Non Cooperation of JE Basim Ali PHE Department, He even didn't attend B₂V₄ w.e.f 28/10/2022 to 29/10/2022.
3. Main Road to Mohalla Jattau, cutting made 5 yrs ago, no work after then.
4. Hand pump Banchayat Lihar was disable, Rs 0.60 lac was sanctioned for upgradation by immercible motor for this pump, work shown completed in paper but on ground level there was zero work.
5. Chokidar Mohd Khurshid appointed in Panchayat didn't receive any kind of payment for last 18 yrs.
6. Sanction of Headmaster post and master grade posts additional teachers PGM & computer trained teachers for H/s Banwat having strength of 335 students.
