Findings

- During my visit to both Hala local block school PWD function, the following observations were made:
  - PWD is functioning quite satisfactorily. No complaint was received.
  - PWD department has started a library containing 1000 books (Twenty thousand pages), but as yet it doesn't contain books only 10,000 pages, there may be asked from PWD to increase the number of books.
  - Department of PDS, has started a food store consisting book & stationery, which has not been started.
  - A school's water connection under unplanned. Because G.S. is being laid at ground floor, which is suitable no, the area being laid at ground floor, which is suitable no, the area 5-7 feet snow, if the clay is laid, that will be cover on the second story will be covered at lower cost, which addition the other items of school administration, there need need of additional room for library?
  - In higher secondary school Hala, there is conducted 1 monthly lectures, taught not single candidate in admitted students shown, which is spoken in English even, might need Urdu lectures in the said H.S. secondary school.
  - There is acute need of STC, M/F, other sources from Hala.
  - Tourism department shall encourage the local Camping Home stay function, as there is high p to Tourism.
  - PWD department should create a community hall. The use of general office of govt.
  - under "Khelo India" no activity has been organized.

Most Imporant Demand for over all  
Socio-economic change of the Area

- ④ Branch of SBI bank is urgently required as people have been demanding it since first bank is village program. We request you public the bank is already sanctioned.
- ⑤ A road "Hatkot to Rector Top" is urgently required. The road is hardly 8-10 Km, was road can connect Hatkot to Rector & will be beneficial for approach to our population (Khatri & Melu) & will give boost to tourist potential of the area when there are motorizing tractors & trucks. By just construction of 10 Km road it will be much more convenient journey to rally.
- ⑥ There is acute need of PHC as vast population is left without any medical facilities.
