Overall Assessment and Suggestion

During B₂V₄ visit and meetings / discussions held with people and Panchayat members, Good co-ordination is found between Public and Private of the Govt. departments. The major demand of people is network tower and internet as people don't get access to internet they have to depend on others for filling of documents etc online and cannot have first hand information about various schemes. There is no bank branch in the Panchayat. One major issue is water under Jal shakti, which is a long pending demand of people of Panchayat. There is a need to organize Awareness camps in the Panchayat regularly, as long as the network issue is not resolved so that the people of Panchayat can be made aware of various Govt. schemes for their benefit.
