Assessment of visiting officer B.V.V.

1. The PWSY department failed to compensate the land owners and start the construction work of Limbu Badvali and Limbu Bahajal roads. The land roads have been tendered since 2008 and 2012 respectively but till date no construction work had been started which affects the whole Panchayat Hells. The department has been suggested in Gram Sabha that the land roads must be tendered again after getting proper NoC from the Wildlife department. The suggestion has been accepted by the A.C. PWSY and assured in Gram Sabha that the dept. will take the matter on priority basis to sort out the issues. So, that the construction and maintenance of roads can be marked out.
2. All the people of Panchayat complaint against PDD that after getting grant of Rs. 7 Lakhs from PHS and tendered the works for poles and wires. After allotment of work billed amount was disbursed to contractor without the completion certificate issued by PHS. After verification of the matter on spot it was found that poles were erected without insulators and steel wire, which is matter of concern for general public of Panchayat Hells - 'B'. A committee should be framed and matter should be investigated to cross-check the estimate and disbursement of billing amount so, that the amount granted by PHS should be saved for general public. PHS.
3. Govt Ration Store should be sanctioned and PHS should be sanctioned for Hells - 'B'.
4. Issue of Network Connectivity should be resolved on war footing basis.
