

Overall assessment of the visiting officer

During the period of my visit to the Panchayat Barwulla, Kangan on 28th and 29th October, 2022, many issues/things were brought to my notice. The people at large were cooperative but complained of non-fulfilment of the demands raised during the previous B2V programmes. Undersigned interacted with different class of people who showed their concern about the general issues/problems faced by the common masses. The Sarpanch of the Halqa Panchayat and her team of Panchas also raised various issues concerning the area. Evaluating all the demands/issues raised during the period of my visit, the following issues need to be taken up positively:-

1. The land identified for play ground and presently earth filling going on may not be converted for any other purposes rather need to be demarcated and made functional so that the young generation of the area uses it in a better way.
2. Retrieval of the "Gass Charayi", which was the concern of each and every one need to be taken up with the concerned authorities. Undersigned spoke to Tehsildar concerned who promised to take appropriate action during the ensuing retrieval drive.
3. The construction work of the Panchayat Ghar is completed but not handed over yet due to some issues with the contractor. This issues needs to be addressed immediately and the Panchayat Ghar made functional.
4. A number of inner link roads leading to the main roads need immediate repairs especially the two roads leading to the Health and Wellness Centre should be the priority.
5. At various places, I witnessed that electricity lines are carried over trees and other structures in absence of Electric Poles and even some households are without the basic need of electricity. Around 60 poles are required to make the area fully electrified.
6. Some persons showed their willingness to establish the Sheep Farms. Undersigned spoke to Director Sheep Husbandry Department in this regard. A camp regarding the awareness about the Animal and Sheep Husbandry Department schemes may be organised in the area and the willing persons engaged in this profession.
