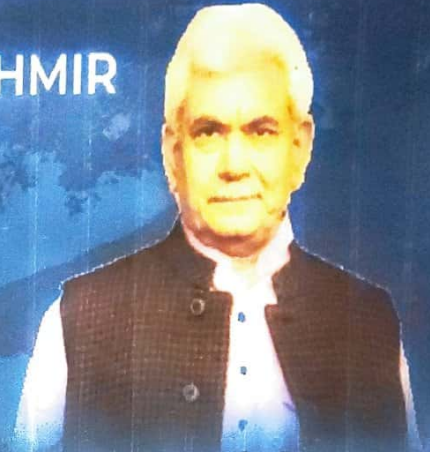

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISTING OFFICER

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: Hanging electricity wires over rotten wooden poles posing threat to inhabitants of the Panchayat also few govt. depts. have no presence in the Panchayat due to which benefit of govt. schemes can't be availed by the locals.
II	Major/ urgent public demands that was/ were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: Road connectivity to the Panchayat & its wards & also to the famous religious place for Hindus & Muslims situated on the hill top of "Galla Dhar" peak. Boundary clarity of two districts i.e. Doda & Ramban as the locals are not getting their issues resolved since they are being asked by the officers of one distt. to go to the other distt. which adds to the difficulties of people.
III	Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in details along with concrete suggestions) Being provided Panchayat is situated in hilly & difficult terrain should be provided with road connectivity so that the inhabitants get some relief from hardship of life & also the tourism potential of the Panchayat be exploited. Also the boundary dispute between two distt. Doda & Ramban must be resolved so that the people should avail benefits of govt. schemes meant for them. Health care facilities should be improved.
