INSTRUCTIONS

He/she shall refrain himself/herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the institution. He/she shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her view should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the

area to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitment.

While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected in viable schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative officers in CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting in district CSS plans.

He/she shall be shared core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.

The Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that at least one RDD official (Ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities. Planned Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.

The officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level. Final copy of the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on the sarpanch's letter portal, before they leave panchayat.

He/she should carry youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, etc. and carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
