MESSAGE

After tremendous success of B2V3, the UT government led by my Hon'ble LG Shri Manoj Sinha Ji sir has vigorously launched Fourth phase of this 8-day long programme of Back to Village (B2V4) commencing from 27th October, 2022. The programme mainly focuses on four broad objectives-

- Energizing all 4291 panchayats of the UT

- Capturing economic potential of the panchayats to synchronize them with decentralization goals
- Undertaking unbiased assessment of needs of villages

Worthy Chief secretary of Jammu and Kashmir, Shri Arun Kumar Mehta Sir has stressed that public feedback about the working of government offices in local areas is a significant component of policy making regarding which this programme will play a key role. Other than this, spreading and evaluating awareness among masses about all online portals and prompt services offered by the government and promoting digital literacy and inclusion among the villagers to take benefit of government services and deliverables efficiently would be significant part of this Jan Abhiyan.

The programme methodology covers major visits by various bureaucrats to languishing projects and leading institutions in the panchayat in order to assess the ground situation and submit a comprehensive report regarding the success of various schemes including a holistic view while celebrating involvement of all stakeholders in the policy making. In Kupwara district, 33

prominent officers will be visiting different panchayats. Worthy Deputy Commissioner has expressed his desire to specify exact locations of the programme in such a way that a diversified perspective can be collected. As this is a joint effort and an important outreach initiative to tailor the schemes according to ground realities and improve overall efficiency of service delivery and hence ensure good governance, it is outrightly inevitable that all supporting staff has to ensure that all necessary interactions are facilitated in a way which ensures another massive response along with achievement of all objectives envisaged by visiting officers.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.

He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.

While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans.

His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.

Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.

Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukh, bhrashtachar mukh, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

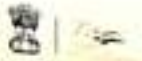

Today on 31/10/2022: visited the Halga Panchayat Hanganah block. Qualified but could not get any cooperation on the part of the Panchayat Halga members. Only Sarpanch and Deputy Sarpanch and very few prominent citizens remained present and gave their full cooperation and on the second day visit. The Panch and other citizens cooperation was not too good. The line departments were present except few i.e. Fisheries and Sewerage due to which I couldn't receive information from the said department. The people have lost their faith on Govt departments as well as B2V programmes while inspecting the works through different schemes I received a number of grievances regarding the pendency of financial release and incomplete works lying under different department i.e. R&B, Irrigation and Flood Control. I came to know that from B2V, to B2V3 till present little bit works have been done through RDO, R&B, Health & Social Welfare departments. But the overall development in different sectors in the Halga Panchayat has remained dream, there is no availability of Krishi Centre (CSC) due to which people are unaware regarding the different schemes launched by the Govt from time to time.
