2. All frontline Workers of department are not deliver their duties while the people of panchayat praises Agriculture & RDD but has major Complaint against Horticulture Sheep Husbandry department.
3. The Panchayat needs a new building ^{for} health Centre and are willing to provide land.
4. All the people in panchayat says in one go that Constructoin of road from Zangam Via Wudar to Nehalpora is essential.
5. For economic prosperity the panchayat needs development in dairy farming, fruit processing Units, Sheep Rearing Units etc.
6. The people are suffering for Transiction of money as no ATM Counter is available. So Panchayat needs Upgradation of JCB Bank & an ATM Counter of JCB Bank.
