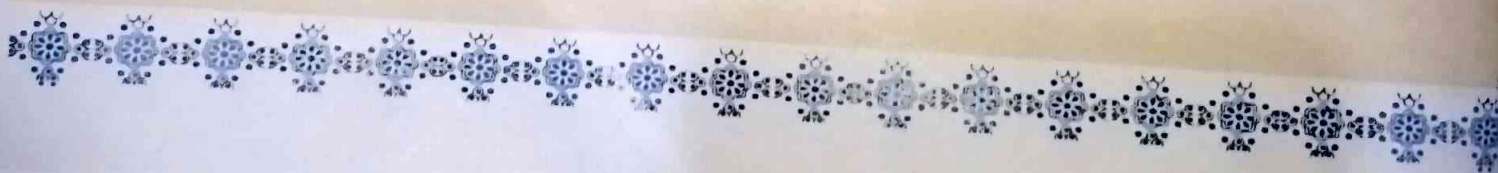

Additional 3 room class room accomodation for GMS Kulthoon and protection bund adjacent to school on Nallah Johru.

Horticulture dept has 55 kanals of land in Kulthoon, needs to be upgraded as it lies in shambles.

Badami bagh, Watayen which is under control of Horticulture deptt may be handed over to tourism and developed as a modern tourist park as horticulture deptt is not doing any significant work, this is demand of local people.


PMAY & SBM portal may be reopened immediately.

Kahchari (State land) has been encroached in Kultora maybe retrieved from encroachers and handed over panchayat for contribute of future assets.

Action of roadside popular trees in Kultora may be taken up on priority basis as they ~~can~~ can become source of life threatening incidents.

Also popular trees under the possession of horticulture dept may also be entrusted off. The SPL employees of P.D.O.D are working satisfactorily and hence their services may be regularised.
