

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.





Subject : - Memorandum regarding sanction of protection on wall to Raghunath Temple, sanction of District playground near Govt. Middle School Neera (Battli), sanction of 400m road and shed to cemetery, re-construction on footpath from Mihar to Neera, modification of electricity line from Maitra to Neera, sanction of compensation to affected by land slides by National Highway constructed by NHAI and acceleration of work of Panchayat under at Neera.

Dear Sir / Madam,

① we are writing to inform you that due to natural calamity ie. flood Raghunath Temple is in red zone, so there is a need of protection wall so that temple would be safe in future.

② 1 km road constructed by PWD from Raghunath Temple to Kohi, due to this a playground completely destroyed therefore kindly grant a financial aid and 200 Karmal state land to District playground near Govt. Middle School Neera (Battli).

There is a lack of road and shed to cemetery near Chenab river Neera.

- ① Due to construction of link road from Mihar to Neera (approx. 4 km) old foot path is totally destructed, so Sir kindly grant re-construction as funds.
- ② Another trouble is POD limit station is installed at Maitra, whenever flash flood and storm occurs, electricity poles get sit down, so we want direct electricity - line by excluding Karel and from Maitra to Neera.
- ③ National Highway NH-44 constructed by NHAI due to this by regular land sliding a huge loss happened to farm and houses. So compensation should be granted to deprived people.
- ④ In 2011, a construction of Panchayat Bhawan was started in Neera but till its house to is not completed So Sir, its construction work should be accelerated.
- ⑤ Public and students are affected because of proper timely Mini-Bus service from Neera to Ramban. So there should be a Mini-Bus service from Neera to Ramban.
