

- (vii) Natural resources, such as springs, Malle's rivers be protected / conserved.
- (viii) Construction of foot path on both sides of main road in Udrama Bazar.
- (ix) Provision for lifting of garbage from the Panchayat.
- (x) Provision of internet facility / water connection / electricity for Panchayat Ghar.
- (xi) Provision of Play ground for youths and children.

Major complaints:

P-46

1. The land for Panchayat Ghar needs to be identified as per revenue records and made its possession to Panchayat. At the same time the Panchayat Ghar which is in dilapidated condition needs to be re-constructed. The public & PRI members complained that this demand regarding Panchayat Ghar has been brought into the notice of visiting officers right from B2V1 and is still pending.
2. Digital signatures of Sarpanch are not activated due to death of existing Sarpanch. This has created two problems in the Panchayat.
 - (i) The payments of the work done in the Panchayat are pending since his death (ex-Sarpanch).
 - (ii) The Panchs in the Panchayat are divided into two groups as four of the existing Panchs are against the Naib Sarpanch and want that new Sarpanch be elected through voting by them for which they have also representation to the Aps.
3. Due to this groupism four of the existing Panchs boycotted from the Back to Village Programme. as such village development plan could not be prepared in the B2V4 in the GP in Grama Sabha.
4. Some public representatives also complained that some work done in respect of P/Path, tiling of Path, drainage etc is not satisfactory.

Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions :- P-49

The visit to Back to Village in this Panchayat has been an exemplary experience. This step of Back to Village taken by the Govt is an excellent step to check the schemes/policies provided by the Govt. for the welfare of general public. Due to this visit not only there has been a check on the policies/schemes implemented in the Panchayats but it has also provided an opportunity to interact with general public through Youths, Mahila Sabhas, Bal Sabhas and other citizens and convey them the various schemes launched by the Govt. through the mob. App. link "my scheme on" Nasha Mukht Abhiyan etc in convergence with other department's functioning in the Panchayat.

After visiting entire Panchayat and interacting with the PRI members, senior citizens, youths etc it was concluded that the following demands of the public must be considered for overall development of the gram Panchayat.

1. Construction of Panchayat Ghar.
2. The road connectivity as demanded by Public
3. Restoration of irrigation khul.
4. Resolution of dispute of Panchs.
5. Provision of dispensary / medical staff for Panchayat
6. Provision of play ground for youth & children and some of genuine demands of Public.
