Major concern in the panchayat deals with -

- ① Boundary walls in all six schools. Cook/sweeper in the schools don't get any remuneration
- ② ICDS centres are only two in seven wards. There is dire need to have five more such centres
- ③ PMGSY road from hasil to Monbal is in dilapidated condition, no road side drainage and R walls not constructed. Besides, this PMGSY road from Shiltara to Malik Mohalla also has drainage and R/walls issue.
- ④ Road connection to Wukroosa / Jungle Mohalla / Peer Mohalla required at an earliest
- ⑤ Veterinary centres required for Shiltara and Band
- ⑥ Transformer required for Peer Mohalla
- ⑦ Electric poles with conductors required for Chongeli
- ⑧ Distribution water pipes required for Chongeli Wukroosa and Takaya Mohalla's.
