


#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in t village.
- He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to admir trative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflect it under district/CSS plans
- His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.

Thus, no need to visit multiple Government websites.

In the portal, schemes are available across a wide range of sectors such as

The Unified Integrated Accessible, Transparent portal (e-UNNAT) with URL <a href="http://eunnat.ik.gov.in">http://eunnat.ik.gov.in</a>, developed, deployed and hosted in J&K State Data centre by Information Technology department, on-boarded with 107 online services fully integrated with Meri Pechaan (National Single Sign On) also provides a glimpse into the My Scheme portal of the Government of India by providing access to information on the schemes by re-directing through a single URL.
