1. PS Prankot is closed since 1998. Even after repeated request, the school is not opened due to various reasons. Due to this about 120 children are suffering very badly. Out of 4 schools only two are functional that too have lack of staff.
2. Electricity is also a major demand of the village. Only a small part of village is electrified.
3. No water supply in the village. A demand of 6 crores has been sanctioned since 2000 but tenders not yet placed. Water supply is very urgent need of village.
4. A middle school is also required as it is very far flung area. PS Bani may be upgraded to middle school.
5. A medical sub-centre is major demand of the village. A medical sub-centre should be opened at Thakikot W. NO. 1.
6. Road Connectivity is demanded from Prankot to Shakti Kol, Baniain to Marg Ladda to Thakikot under NABARD. Bada Bani to still.
7. Seasonal Educational Centre is demanded at Prankot.
8. Anganwadi Centres at Nandla W. NO. 2 Chaurian W. NO. 4, Marg W. NO. 6, Toki W. NO. 1 Prankot W. NO. 6 are demanded.
9. Bath room and Tanki at PS NO. 27. Shaktikot + Polling Station NO. 38 Prankot is demanded.



Overall assessment of Village and Suggestions.

I want to bring in the notice of authorities that Panchayat is situated at very far flung area and lacks basic infrastructure. Govt. departments are defunct except few. People suffering very badly and nobody is listening to what they demand. Water, electricity, Education, Medical facilities are a dream for them. Road Connectivity is one of the major issues.

Suggestions :- Most important thing is to connect the village through an all weather road without which no development is possible. Road Connectivity issue has to be taken up at war footing as our ^{new} generation can not be left deprived of basic facilities. All other issues will be solved once the village is connected to road.
