







### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, neither observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from further interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative dept under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one BDO official (Ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all works as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on [www.jkpanchayat.in](http://www.jkpanchayat.in) portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrastrachar mukt, Soaga yakt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and satuate them.

RPP Dept: The first part of the Zingap Road was completed and the work done was satisfactory.

Educators: The 8 studs P's for students was to be upgraded to 1/3 level bus drive. However Jadda which is about 2 kms & busy needs the children come very far & most difficult road could reach far institutions. On primary Jadda needs a primary school.

The m/s kadda needs footpath, both sides which are badly damaged. One best school boys & girls may be combined on primary. One ground also needs levelling & improvement. Furniture may be about 20% to be done on primary (WMS) and on secondary.

## NOTES

Angamwari center

One Angamwari center at Kadda was inspected. The first store, kitchen and furniture was also checked. However the other Director's from civil department also revealed the RPP and inspected the Angamwari center on road. He also discussed many difficulties faced by these women in this remote area (Bully) which is not covered by road.

Also more than 18 houses under construction under PMAY scheme were also visited. One wardens

namely Kalya Katarani in far side needs to be benefited under PMAY. WMS - Point And Kadda (Bully) in needs to be covered under PMAY (WMS).




