Overall Assessment & Suggestions

The two days B₂V₄ Programme conducted by the Govt. of J&K (UT) from 15th October to 3rd November 2022 has mentally stimulated the general public at the grassroot level and has given them a feeling that something creative is going to happen, keeping aside all the happenings over recent past. The people feel satisfied and enthusiastic that the Government is serious for the first time in knowing/analysing the problems faced by the people and were hopeful in resolving their grievances through a bridge viz. B₂V₄ Programme. The people feel that most of the works undertaken at B₂V₁, B₂V₂ and B₂V₃ have not been redressed but still they are optimistic that B₂V₄ could be a turning point for the redressal of their genuine demands.

The main agenda put forward by the youth of the Panchayat Halaqa have demanded a play ground but unfortunately their genuine demand has not been redressed till date.

The electric network and drinking water facility has not been provided as per the desire and demand of the people.

The Banking facility regarding the establishment of a Banking Business Unit, upgradation of Govt. Middle School Bumdoora to High School and repatriation of the sanctioned staff to PHC Bumdoora are the concerns of the people.

Suggestions:-

1. Provision of a playground. (Urgent)
2. Upgradation of existing electric net-work.
3. Upgradation of drinking water facility.
4. Establishment of Animal Husbandry and Sheep Unit.
5. Paving of the streets / internal link roads.
6. Proper drainage of the village.
