The people of the Panchayat are peace loving and interested in progress of the Panchayat. They are hopeful that Govt; is the only capable agency to install change and help develop people through enlightened policies. The Panchayat seem to be unaware about the schemes of almost all the departments. There is scarcity of safe drinking water; no road connectivity to the village hamlets; no dispensaries; no Phe and no playgrounds. The schools are short of staff; lack of adequate infrastructure; waiting of rationalisation of staff and more particularly the st-population of Shabinbase area needs immediate attention as there are live electric wires hanging on the wooden poles; trees and running close to the houses. More importantly, the PMAY and T A V beneficiaries in the region require release of their pending installments as they are really living in inhuman ~~and~~ <sup>open</sup> circumstances. Hope before the winter snow, they may be get a space and shelter to live in.
