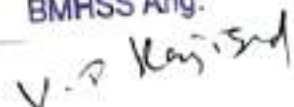

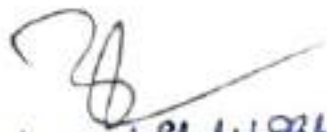

(III) OVERALL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISIT AND SUGGESTIONS:-

ASSESSMENT:-

ON REACHING KANJIGUND ALONG WITH FRONTLINE WORKERS FROM OTHER DEPARTMENTS I FOUND A PRACTICALLY VISIBLE DISCONNECT BETWEEN THE PEOPLE AND THE GOVT. INFACIT MANY DEPARTMENTS LIKE HORTICULTURE, SHEEP HUSBANDARY, FLORICULTURE, SOIL & WATER CONSERVATION, INDUSTRIES AND COMMERCE, GEOLOGY/MINING AND HANDICRAFT WERE INTRODUCED FIRST TIME TO PUBLIC BY THE VISITING OFFICER. IT WAS FOUND THAT NO DEVELOPMENTAL WORKS ARE BEING EXECUTED IN THAT AREA EXCEPT CONSTRUCTION OF A FEW COMPOST AND SOAK PITS UNDER MGNREGA. IT WAS FOUND THAT MANY PMAY BENEFICIARIES WERE IDENTIFIED EARLIER BUT ONLY 01 FAMILY HAS BEEN BENEFITED IN 2022 THAT TOO WITH 1ST INSTALLMENT ONLY. THE PEOPLE WERE CONCERNED AS TO WHY THE DEMANDS OF PREVIOUS B2V-PROGRAMS HAVE NOT BEEN MET. THE PEOPLE ALSO SEEM TO LACK AWARENESS REGARDING MANY SCHEMES LAUNCHED BY GOVT FROM TIME TO TIME. PEOPLE OF THE AREA ALSO RAISED SERIOUS CONCERNS AND ALLEGATIONS OF CORRUPTION AND FAVOURITISM AGAINST VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS RESPONSIBLE FOR UNDERDEVELOPMENT, BACKWARDNESS AND INADEQUACIES FOUND IN THIS PANCHAYAT HALQA.
