The inhabitants of the panchayats are generally keeping good perception regarding the overall functioning of all departments. But some departments are hardly visible on the ground. Agriculture, Irrigation, Horticulture, Sheep and Animal Husbandry are some departments which need to aware the people about different centrally sponsored schemes. Education and RDD are making best use of their manpower to look after the needs of the people and aware them about the schemes.

## THREE MAJOR OBSERVATIONS/ASSESSMENT
