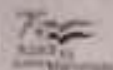

Schools of Panchayat Halqa Poshtkar =

- 1.) Main Public Demand of the Panchayat Halqa Poshtkar is UPGRADATION of High School Poshtkar upto Higher Secondary Level. As per Public report H/S Poshtkar always remained to be at S.no 1 but when list of upgraded schools were published in the past our School is being found no where. Students of the area are suffering a lot and has to cover 5 kms by foot to reach the HSS Khag.
- 2.) Construction of Tile Path 300 ft at Middle School Poshtkar as during rainy days students suffer due to mud.
- 3.) Establishment of Computer Lab at Middle School Poshtkar as the School has sufficient accomodation and roll and is one of the leading School in Kone Khag.
- 4.) Physical Education Teacher to be posted at M/S Poshtkar as the School has sufficient roll and playground. The



Middle Schools having less roll than M/S Poshkar has, been provided Physical education Teacher, reason not known why M/S Poshkar has been ignored.

- 4.) Construction of boundary wall around High School Poshkar with tin.
- 5.) Construction of Conference hall at H/S Poshkar
- 6.) Construction of retaining wall near school lab of H/S Poshkar as land is sliding.
- 07.) Old school building of Primary School Hanipora (Mithra) is unsafe as per on spot visit made by visiting officer and whole team, so recommendation is made to construct 5 roomed building and separate Girls toilet.
