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GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.

Major Complaints brought to notice of visiting officers

- ① Line Departments are not holding awareness camps about their schemes in village.
- ② Govt Middle School Alambal Bhandupura is functioning in just four (4) rooms & without any basic utilities.
- ③ Only one (1) Anganwadi Centre is functioning in whole Mandal & which is a huge area.
- ④ The Jail Bangle is order for Guarantee on the Sponsored cars under various schemes offered by Government & makes its absolute problematic for people to take loan.
- ⑤ The electric lines in Alambal/Bhandupura are laid over trees. Instead of electric poles & likely hood of any mishap in future cannot be ruled out.
- ⑥ Municipality should immediately install DUSTBINS near Jail bangle. Nambal Bhandupura as the area has become a hotspot for Sewage.
- ⑦ Ladli-Beti Schemes despite being currently running across Karnataka is still yet to be launched in District Banaville, Simlahy Beti, Bacha Beti padra.
- ⑧ The water available in Alambal/Bhandupura is absolutely unfit for human consumption, the visiting officer while having a Sip of water himself found it filthy & unfit for human health & there is absolute urgency that portable drinking water should be made available to people.
- ⑨ The area being a border between District Banaville & District Bidgam poses some Jurisdictional Crisis, in various Departments. For example it was brought to notice of visiting officer that Banaville Poo department says they don't have jurisdiction, while in Bidgam they are to have jurisdiction.
- ⑩ Jail Bangle operative in area doesn't accept Sponsored cars of District Banaville under various schemes, claim jurisdiction issue, viz; Bati is mapped with District Bidgam & can take care of Bidgam only.

11. SAC's of the area complained that there should be a Governmental Intervention for their produce, so that they would be able to sell their produce without involvement of middle man,

iii Overall assessment of the visit & suggestions (overall merit & suggestions) C.

At the outset the visit to this Panchayat has been satisfactory & all people belonging to this Panchayat Hadga (PH-21) Mopand-B provided an un-conditional support & co-operation during the visit. Besides members of PRI's also provided their support in this phase of Back to village programme. However at the same time, there were certain grave issues which were brought to the notice of visiting officer & have been brought into notice, of the major complaints part of this booklet of BZV4. ~~there are certain~~. An immediate problem at the moment that this visiting officer noted during visit to PH-21 was the absolute Jurisdictional issues. Considering this area being a border between District Budgam & District Baramulla, having said that it came to light that there are variety of issues confronting the residents of this village regarding jurisdiction. ex: on visit to a village Bante (nearest branch of Jale Bante), it was stated that despite being a Bante established on land of District Baramulla, the loan cones, particularly sponsored cones of different Government Departments of District Baramulla are not admitted, on enquiring from Bante members it came transpired that Bante branch of Jale Bante although on land of District Baramulla is mapped with District Budgam & cones pertaining to different Government Sponsored Schemes Vested from District Budgam are admitted only. Similarly the Panchayat was grave problem of electric poles & similarly the visiting officer saw electric lines running over trees, which could snowball into a major mishap for life & property for the residents. The visiting officer noted that no Panchayat plan for this Panchayat has been yet constructed. Similarly there was a grave issue of ~~no~~ portable water availability in the village & this visiting officer on tasting the water himself found it totally un-suitable for drinking purposes & can be a cause of serious health ailments for residents.

During the visit to the village school (Gms - Alambal) it was found that school is functioning in just four rooms without basic amenities of toilet water availability, proper accommodation, power connection. The school was also not fenced & without any play field. Similarly the station host was too unable to meet requirement of the food grains of the village.

Suggestions

1. Nearest branches or branches of Jale Bank & other banks in the areas need to be mapped with District Bank, so that people of this village panchayat would be also able to process their loans / sponsored loans with these banks. The bank authorities need to be directed to solve this issue once for all.
2. Portable water be made available to the village residents, this is an immediate need for a filtration plant.
3. Electric poles need to be erected, so that electric lines laid over trees are done away with & eventuality of any mishap is avoided.
4. A full fledged panchayat shala for this panchayat (PH-21) should be constructed at an earliest, the villages have identified land in this regard near Bund Alambal.
5. Jurisdictional issues confronting this area be solved by way of proper delegation of jurisdiction & power upon the Government Departments, who would function in the area.
