



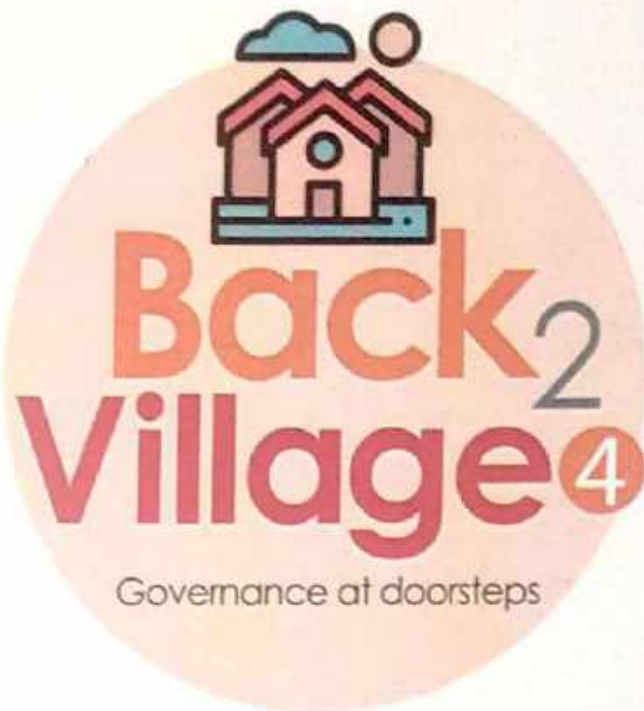

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans.
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas

MyScheme a national platform that aims to offer one-stop search and discovery of the Government schemes, providing an innovative, technology-based solution to discover scheme information based upon the eligibility of the citizen was launched in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir by the Chief Secretary, J&K on 12-08-2022, thereby **J&K became first union territory among all the States/UTs to on-board its schemes on MyScheme portal.**

The easy user interface of myScheme help the citizens to find the right Government schemes by directing the citizen to the application page of the scheme of their choice, thereby not only reduces the time and effort of citizens in searching for appropriate government schemes but also guides on how to apply for different Government schemes. **Thus, no need to visit multiple Government websites.**

In the portal, schemes are available across a wide range of sectors such as

4. Banking, Financial Services & Insurance,
5. Social welfare, Revenue, Transport, Tourism etc

MyScheme offers a convenient three- step process for the citizens to discover the government schemes for which they are eligible i.e. the user enters his /her attributes such as demographic, income, social details, etc.; List of Schemes to look into; & the user can select from the list of eligible schemes and get detailed information regarding the scheme

The Unified Integrated Accessible, Transparent portal (**e-UNNAT**) with URL <http://eunnat.jk.gov.in>, developed, deployed and hosted in J&K State Data centre by Information Technology department, on-boarded with 107 online services fully integrated with **Meri Pehchaan (National Single Sign On)** also provides a glimpse into the My Scheme portal of the Government of India by providing access to information on the schemes by re-directing through a single URL.

Subject: Conduct of meeting of Biodiversity Management Committee (BMC) during Fourth Phase of Back to Village Programme (B2V4).

The Government of J&K has constituted Biodiversity Management Committees (BMCs) in all the 4,290 Village Panchayats and 76 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) as per the Biological Diversity Act, 2002 & Rules, 2004 for conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity. The BMCs are mandated to document the biodiversity (all life forms, plants, and animals) under their jurisdiction in the form of Peoples Biodiversity Register (PBR). The PBRs have already been prepared for all the Village Panchayats, however being a dynamic document, it is updated periodically. Other responsibilities of BMCs are:

1. Conservation and sustainable utilization of biological resources.
2. Eco-restoration of local biodiversity.
3. Documentation & protection of traditional knowledge.
4. Management of biodiversity heritage sites.
5. Conservation of traditional varieties/breeds of important plants & animals.
6. Biodiversity education & awareness creation.

As per the Operational Guidelines issued by National Biodiversity Authority, a BMC shall hold minimum four meetings in a year and meet at least once in 3 months. Hence, it is advised to all the officers/officials nominated for the "Fourth Phase of Back to Village Programme (B2V4)" to attend the meeting of Biodiversity Management Committees of the villages allotted to them and deliberate on issues pertaining to conservation of biodiversity and sustainable utilization of biological resources, besides creation of awareness on biodiversity. The meeting of BMC will be facilitated by Panchayat Secretary/VLW.

The agenda points that may be taken up during the meeting of the BMC are given as under:-

1. Creation of awareness on Biological Diversity Act, 2002 and functions of the BMC including their responsibility on documentation of biodiversity.
2. Listing of Vaid, Hekims and traditional health care practitioners in the village.
3. Listing of individuals possessing traditional knowledge in the village.

4. Listing of Sacred Groves, Sacred Water Bodies, and potential Biodiversity Heritage Sites (Areas outside forests with rich biodiversity which can be conserved and managed by the Village Panchayat).
5. Identification of Non Timber Forest Produce (NTFP) found within the jurisdiction of BMC which can be sustainably collected and utilized.
6. Conservation of traditional varieties/breeds of economically important plants/animals.
7. Need assessment for capacity building of Biodiversity Management Committees.

Lastly there have been some persistent demands in various Back to Village programmes and in this programme (Back to Village 4) also which have not been addressed yet. The demands include, sanctioning of Animal Husbandry Centre at village Au Para, playgrounds at Au Para and Nandpara which need to be fulfilled at the earliest. Further a public library and ~~and~~ crafts centre needs to be sanctioned for the Panchayat.

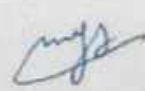
