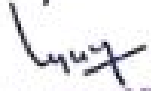

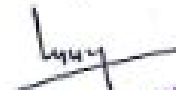

13. Construction of Culvert and filling of road near Munawarabad Checkpora
14. Construction of Overhead on bridge or underway near MS Brazloo for students of MS Brazloo.
15. School boundary wall for MS Brazloo and MS Kantchowa.
16. Repairment and fencing of marriage hall at Brazloo.

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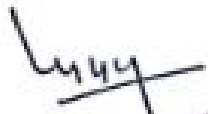

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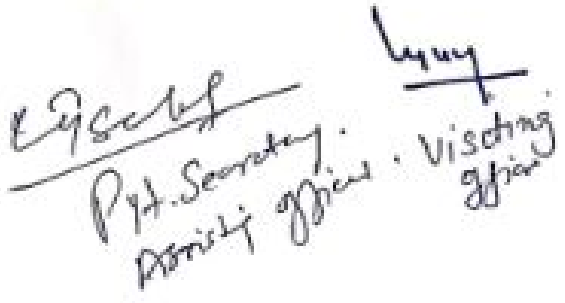

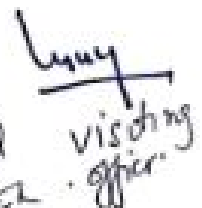
