Overall assessment of visiting officer

On 20/10/2022 and 24/10/2022 visited the village Habber Lassipora as visiting officer as per orders of D.C. Pondgarn, I observed that the people of the village are using drinking water without filtration which causes many hygienic problems. I suggest and request higher up to provide filtration plant for the area.

The road connectivity between Habber and Lassipora is a serious problem which the people of the area face. Link roads need immediate upgradation. Road from Habber to Lassipora taken up by Road B department needs immediate attention for its conclusion/completion.

The medical facilities are totally absent from the village. Medical facilities were not provided to the people of the village till date. No PHC and Sub centre is available in the village. Need of the hour is provide basic medical facilities to the poor and rich as early as possible.

The building constructed for S.H.S, Habber is without drinking water, electricity, fencing and ground. The windows of the school building need iron grills for the safety of records. P/S School Lassipora Habber need govt. building and P/S, Ganie Mohala need building or may be merged with H/S, Habber as the roll of both the institutions is $80 + 30 = 110$.

So far as clean and green village is concerned the Panchayat of the village is to construct soak and compost pits which is an admirable steps towards the clean and green village. The construction work of C.S.C under SBM is going on but at snails speed.

The people of the village face many problems due to non-availability of Banking facilities. Need of the hour is to provide 1st Bank Branch in the area so that the people may not suffer any more. The youth of the village are not getting financial benefits from any bank which creates great hurdles in way of govt. self employment programmes.

PDD upgraded HT lines but LT lines need immediate attention. 15 LT poles and wire/conductor is needed for the village.

The work of Panchayat gas is under process. The park and ~~lake~~ link needs upgradation. The Thumry near the Panchayat gas may be developed and promoted as tourist spot.

The people of the villages are getting benefits from Centrally Sponsored Schemes through Panchayat. The LRS is always at the services of the villagers. Land books were not provided to the people by the Patwari till date. Golden Cards, Kisan Credit Cards, PM Kisan Sammanidhi Cards were provided to the people by concerned departments. AWCs are providing nutritious food to the children and pregnant women regularly.

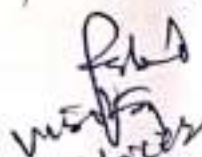
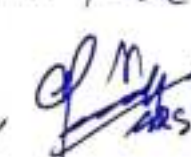
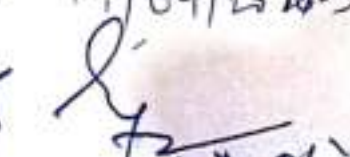

So this is the genuine and legal demand which is necessary to fill. we have been ruthlessly ignored since the opening of the school. (2004)

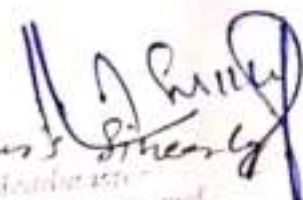

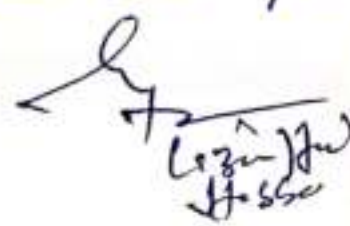

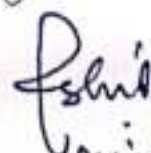
