- ④ Requirement of electric poles & wires.
- ⑤ NTPHC Building required & staff for NTPHC - Nare Nagri.
- ⑥ Enhancement of wages of GRS as they are working with dedication.

As the Panchayat is very remote so basic facilities like electricity, water supply, Health & schools needed to be upgraded.
