Overall assessment of the Panchayat.

The public is not aware of all the schemes which are very useful for them. Many people completed different works but they have not been paid so far such as Bath rooms, Roads, soak pits, grave yards and P/paths, B/paths & T/paths etc. Many people raised the question that funds released for different schemes have not been distributed equally among the Panch wards. Where as some wards more than 5 works at a time through 14 FC, PRI and MGNREGA while some wards of the Panchayat are completely deprived in which no work is allotted.

There is lot of problem of water in every ward except W no 6, 5, 1 & two. The other wards as 3, 4, 7, 8, and 9 are in dire need of water. In these wards there are no pipes. Spring covers and tanks have leakage due to which water cannot be supplied properly. Any PHE official, i.e. JAE AB does not bother to visit the Panchayat once in a year. If all the schemes are implemented properly by the depts and proper representativeness of Sarpanch and Panches the Panchayat can be develop very soon.
