- Some departments such as Animal Husbandry, Health, etc, Panchayat Bhavan/Office do not exist in this Panchayat Halga.

Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions

→ Since the Panchayat has only two members including one Surpanch, the functioning of the Panchayat has not been upto the mark. The Surpanch is a migrant as such remains available for various Committee meeting occasionally.

The Panchayat Halqa is a part of village Akingam. It has not its own Panchayat Bawan. Likewise various departments don't have their own offices in the Panchayat Halqa, viz; Animal husbandry, Revenue, Health, and Education, Social welfare depts are performing very well.

Suggestions: ① Sports play field should be constructed as early as possible so that the youth are restrained from indulging in drug addiction.

② Panchayat Bawan should be constructed as the land is available.

③ No ~~health~~ health sub Centre is available for the residents of Panchayat Halqa. A provision for the same should be made.
