

Higher Secondary Education in Govt Higher Secondary School Mirhama is facing trouble due to space crunch. A new Building is very Badly required for the School. The land has already been identified that needs to be fenced immediately. Besides the DPR for the Const. of the school and subsequent construction needs to be started for the benefit of vast number of students which the school covers. The school is likely to cover many other panchayats Besides the Mirhama Panchayat.

Similarly power sector needs improvement to improve the voltage and potential difference in the Panchayat, since the panchayat falls on the Tail end of the existing feeder. The Deficiencies as Communicated vis-a-vis Transformers and Distribution System need to be looked into immediately.


