Overall Assessment of the visit and suggestions of visiting officer pyt Neota Karyan Block Bhaderwah.

As U/s visited the pyt Neota Karyan Block Bhaderwah, I found that village is suffering to fulfill their basic needs of water supply, electricity and health care centers. The village has no road connectivity as everyone have to travel on foot to reach Seri market and load their heavy goods and belongings on head. The market of Seri is approx. 5km and path is hilly terrain which is not easy at all to walk on. As per locals it become very difficult to take pregnant ladies and sick people to the hospital in time. So this road connectivity is really necessary to the people of pyt Neota Karyan. During snowfall there is no electricity as the old damaged wooden poles fall down and no one from electricity department can visit to restore it. I have also observed that there is not enough space in Schools to perform extra co-curricular activities so a playground is the necessity of the hour. I also visited outskirts of the village and I have observed there is huge potential of Tourism due to lavender and it can be a source of attraction for tourists. Tourism can also generate employment opportunities to the youth and locals of the village. People of this village have high hopes from Govt to consider their demands on Priority basis.
