





Gram Panchayat Resolution

Resolution - 17/11/2022 - 24.

Today on 01-11-2022 a gram was held at village Panchayat Ahadwah Block on Distt-Ramban. The Gram Sabha was chaired by Sarpanch Panchayat Halga including Ward Panchayat in the presence of BZU visiting officer Sh. Raju Zutshi assistant marketing and grading Officer. The Gram Sabha which was attended by elders of the village including GLS and other representatives of respective departments.

The agenda of the meeting was as under:-

1. Road connectivity to Panchayat Ahadwah from Ramban & C.B. Bida via Shargali, Antiga, Chatre etc.
2. Construction of School building which was lying incomplete of High school Baitiya, m/s Ahadwah, extension of playground with fencing, separate toilets for girls and boys and staff room and teaching staff for High school Baitiya, subject specific teachers for high school Baitiya.
3. It was also decided that there should be public Park, with construction wall fencing, passenger shed and water tank with water connection at Ramvrikta shiv shakti mandir Brimthiyal Baitiya need to be developed.
4. Pucca path from Gurnihal to Bida be made along with safety walls.

(5) Protection wall with Pucca path and to prevent land sliding near the house of Sh. Ansari Lal at Haltangan be allotted with sufficient measures.

(6) Primary Health Centre at Ahadwah should be made.

(7) Bank Branch should be made available at Bida and Baitiya of Panchayat Ahadwah.

(8) Patwari Office should be made at Ahadwah Panchayat.

(9) Construction and opening of Community Halls at Baitiya and Bida.

(10) Local picnic spots like Atthi, Pashtali, Darbote, -

- Washigral, Babiya and Luvara should be developed.
- (1) Development of Ramvatika and Passenger Sheds at Ramvatika, Shargali, Darbote, Washigral and Biba.
- (2) There should be proper teaching staff and subject specific staff at Govt High School Babiya, M/s Darbote.
- (3) The work of incomplete building of M/s Darbote should be initiated early as possible.
- (4) Govt. middle school Ahdwal should be upgraded to High School and Building for Middle School Ahdwal should be constructed early as possible.
- (5) Panchayat Ghar should be constructed early as possible.
- (6) Animal, Sheep Husbandry centres should be opened.
- (7) Public Parks in each Ward of Panchayat should be made.
- (8) Pucca Paths connecting each mohalla of each ward, Darbote, Bibi, Hattangan, Bhetta, Thermulla, Babiya, Dakhni, Ganji, Chetra, Shara, Sheri and Garshelli.
- (9) Manches stadium for playing Cricket should be made at Sheera ward no. 5.
- (10) Public Park at Mahakal for ward no. 2 Bibi should be made.
- (11) Solar and electric lights should be installed in each mohalla of each ward of Panchayat Ahdwal.
- (12) Maintenance of P. path from Ramban to Thermulla of Panchayat.
- (13) Re-parking of eleven KV from Ramban to Thermulla should be started.
- (14) Allotting Solar Plant for the Panchayat.
- (15) Passenger sheds at Ramvatika, Shargali, Babiya, Biba and Washigral and Darbote.
- (16) Installation of Pucca bridge at Washigral, Garshelli, and Sheer.
- (17) The works of water shed management should be started.

- (31) Centrally and State Sponsored schemes should be made available to the whole Panchayat Beneficiary.
