Recommendations in respect of some shortcoming noticed in hinf. office/schools/Hospital.

- ① Gms Bandwal:- Post of master and Physical Teacher lying vacant. Needs to be filled. Condition of school playground is not good. Needs to be reworked/renovated by leveling the ground. Some tiles work is needed to beautify the school complex. Plantation in school bldg complex is needed to beautify the school complex.
- ② Govt. by school Chalk Silandar W.No. 6:- School building is very old and have problems of water seepage in ceiling. Needs to be reworked/renovated to plug the seepage problem. There is no boundary wall of school complex. Needs to be constructed.
- ③ Anganwadi Centre:- Anganwadi Centre in Bandwal has good enrollment but these centres have no jars and no containers to store the food items. Needs to be provided.
- ④ Health and Welfare Centre Bandwal:- Post of Pharmacist and Sweeper is vacant - which need to be filled. Though the building of centre is good but the outer entrance and lower space needs to be beautify by plantation which is not in good condition.
- ⑤ PMAT scheme:- Though the funds are being released but the process is very slow which needs to be expedited.
- ⑥ CSC Centre:- Though the building has been constructed and computer and furniture provided but the same is lying dormant/non-functional due to non-deputing/posting of staff which is need to be deployed.



④ MINARECA Work:- Drainage channel has been constructed in W.No. 2 in the year 2017-18 under MINARECA. But the payments has been made partially. The same may be resolved in the interest of timely future development work. Further drainage channel is required to be constructed from
