The undersigned received complaints on the WhatsApp as :</p> <p>Quote</p> <p>"It is to intimate to your goodself that no action is being done by the Officers Concerned latter-on, need to mention here that I, Bashir Ahmad have made representations in the Back to Village Programmes previously so many times at my village at Nowgam Bypass Srinagar with regard to illegal mutation made of our purchased land of 16.1/2 marlas @ ratio of 5.1/2 each (Settlement record shows as 17 marlas) during the year 1991 under Khasra No.911 previous 2115 new, now recorded in the name of Dawood Rashid Mir at Mehjoor Nagar Natipora Srinagar under Khasra No.769 illegally by Sami Ullah Naqashbandi as the land in question is under our possession, but only our Khasra No. has been used to enable to give Power of Attorney illegally for 17 marlas till date the grievance/complaint made with the Worthy Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir who has directed to the Subordinate Officers to settle the issue and submit the ground report within fifteen days for n/action in favour of Officers who have done and are involved in it, in accordance with the contents of the complaint filed by the complainant so many times which have not been settled till date and there is a land mafia of 7.1/2 marlas which costs of Rs.75,00,000/= (Rs. Seventy five lakhs only) @ the market rate of Rs.10,00,000.00 per marlas (Rupees ten lakhs only) which has been grabbed by the said purchaser through Mohammad Maqbool Lone S/O.Abdul Rehman Lone R/o. Budshah Nagar Natipora Srinagar (Property Land Broker).The concerned officers namely Gh .Jeelani Ex. Patwari, Mohammad Ayoub, Ex. Girdwaar and Sami Ullah Naqashbandi Ex Naib Tehsildar of Nowgam, Natipora Srinagar are main accused in this mafia which used their powers beyond to their limits and ignored the instructions of high ups as Published in the Daily News Paper "Greater Kashmir" at that time and a letter served to them by the then Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar, followed by my application for submission of Fard Badder accordingly and the Fard Badder have not been submitted to the high ups due to the fact that they have distributed my encroached land as well as Govt. land among them and made huge corruption mutually in it from the reference Brokers. The complaint filed which has been lodged by me is now lying in the Tehsildar Office, Chanapira-Natipora Srinagar for last two years for submission of the report to the high ups in which the land mafia in question of 4.1/2 marlas belongs to Govt.land and 3 marlas belongs to us which total mafia comes to 7.1/2 marlas of land worth Rs 75,00,000.00 (Rupees Seventy Five Lakhs Only) which is under the possession of Dawood Rashid Mir S/O. Abdul Rashid Mir Retd.Naib Tehsildar R/O. Dardpora Kupwara, illegally and we earlier suggested for construction of Patwar Khana there in the complaint, but the concerned Revenue Officers who are also involved in it are not ready to help their own Revenue Department and now how it is possible to help to us on humanitarian grounds as they have already made corruption in it mutually at the large extent. Now I/We have decided to submit the ground with genuineness/reality report directly to the worthy Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir, under the kind information of His Excellency Chief Secretary of UT of J&K, Srinagar, for early settlement of the long pending issue and appropriate n/action under rules in favour of the Departmental Officials/Officer as well as Land Brokers mentioned above. Further it is stated here that our cusions should have to sold their land out of 1 kanal 15 marlas under Khasra No.912 previous and 2112 new only @ the ratio of 11.1/2 marlas only as per their shares instead of 17 marlas under Warasti Inthikal No.430 which have been helped to them illegally by their Son In Law namely Mohammad Ashraf Hajam S/O. Late Ali Mohammad Hajam R/O. Boogam Chadoora Budgam who is also working as Property Land Broker at Bugam Chadoora area. With Regards Bashir Ahmad 9419711149". Unquote</p> <p>2. Grievance Details:</p> <p>Quote</p> <p>"I Junaid Bashir tak submits as under. That my wife was scheduled for delivery on 28th July 2022. I straight way went to Ahmad Hospital Nowgam Bypass Srinagar for LSCS, wherein the concerned Gynecologist Dr. Meraj followed the surgical procedure (Cesarean) on the same day and date at 4:30 pm. My wife gave birth to a healthy & normal male baby weighted 3.5 Kg .As advised by the Surgeon I got medical checkup of my baby by children</p>
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specialist namely Dr. Siraj in routine matter ,who was present at that time in the Ahmad Hospital against the consultation charges of Rs 1000/= by cash. He also confirmed and added the baby as a healthy one and also advised me for some vaccination in routine. Accordingly my baby has been vaccinated in the said Hospital by one of their paramedical staff on cash payment of Rs 500/=. At the time of vaccination I insisted the concerned paramedical staff member to show me the expiry date of the vaccine, He ignored the same. However the vaccine was already filled in the syringe without any cover. After vaccine injection my baby feel some fever which I have took as usual boz of vaccination. Thereafter on the next day (after 20 Hrs) I found some rashes/Swelling/Abuses developed to my baby at the said vaccination spot of (right thigh) I immediately informed the authorities of said Hospital regarding the issue but they said we are helpless as no doctor is available in the Hospital at the time. However they call Dr Siraj and told him the whole story of my baby on that he directed them to shift the baby to GB Pant Hospital as it is impossible for me to come Hospital. I was informed by Hospital authorities to move GB Pant Hospital immediately. I accordingly insisted them to provide Ambulance services and a Doctor so that i can be able to admit my baby in emergency ward but they couldn't. However I immediately rushed to GB Pant Hospital in my own vehicle and after entiring efforts succeeded to admit the baby there. The Doctors of GB Pant Hospital try their best level to save the life of my baby but the vaccinated infection had quickly spread all over the body ,as also confirmed by Doctors of GB Pant Hospital .Finally my baby expired on 31 July 2022 at 7pm. The SHO P/S Nowgam and Director Health Services were already informed by the fact but no action has been taken till date. So your August authority is requested to intervene in the matter on humanitarian grounds viza-viz the Concerned SHO Police station Nowgam and Director Health Services Kashmir may kindly be directed to lodge an FIR against the administration of Ahmad Hospital Bypass Nowgam and also get it investigated through Crime Branch Kashmir or any other central agency so that justice will take place and the precious lives of the patients admitted in the Ahmad Hospital in future may be saved and the malpractice may be stopped in the hospital. Further I lodged grievances at LG's/PM's Grievance Portal nd where Directorate of Health Services reports that the case will be investigated by District AEFI Committee, since the jurisdiction of AEFI committee is to Probe the Vaccination part only not investigate the negligence of paramedical staff or administration of Ahmad Hospital. So I seek Director Health's stance on the issue mentioned below and what action has been taken so far against the accused Hospital. No Resident Doctor was available in the Hospital at the time of emergency.2. No Proper referral was carried out due to absence of staff. 3. No Ambulance Service was provided to the victim which caused delay in the treatment of child. I request the Honab'le Lt. Governor /Director Health to cancel the license of the accused Hospital to prevent such Malpractices. With regards **Junaid Bashir Tak 9906844215.**"
