





Subject: - Detailed report of Back to Village 4 for Panchayat Halqa Kewa.

Respected Sir,

I have been assigned the assignment of Visiting Officer for B2V4 for Panchayat Halqa Kewa and during my assignment, it was noted that public presence was just a finger-counted number. While trying to access this poor response it was noted that people are not satisfied with the follow-up of the previous B2V. Therefore after assessing those previous booklets I hereby submit my detailed report as under;

1. **Drinking Water:-** in all previous B2V programs, every time the general public raised serious concerns over the unavailability of safe drinking water, and after assessing the present situation it was noted that till date the concerned Panchayat Halqa is getting drinking water which is truly unsafe for drinking and no Filtration plant is working in the Halqa.
2. **Widening of Road:-** from B2V1 to B2V3 local public demanded the widening of the Road from Qazigund to Malikabad but till today due to unknown reasons the concerned department is not able to start this project.
3. **Flood protection walls:-** During previous B2Vs, the local public demanded that the irrigation department should construct Flood Protection walls but till today nothing such as happened in the area and only a few places irrigation canals are getting on their way however Protection Wall on the river is yet to get constructed.
4. **Upgradation of LT:-** During previous B2V's it was demanded by the general public that the LT network may kindly be modified/improved but till today no such assignment has been taken by the concerned department. However, it is worth mentioning that at present HT networking has been modified. Keeping in view the LT networking- at some places, it was seen that broken wooden poles are acting as LT poles & at some places, branches of trees are acting as LT Poles and in both cases, general public life is at risk. Apart from Poles in the Panchayat Halqa, it was noted down that the wiring network is of low standard and single line wire is acting as LT Line which is also keeping the life of all living at stake secondly the heavy risk of fire is raising in the Panchayat Halqa.
5. **Sports Stadium:-** in the previous B2V it was demanded that a sports Stadium may kindly be constructed and that assignment has been somehow completed but after assessing the situation, it was noted that the said stadium may be volatile at one stage as the concerned Panchayat Halqa is of 03 big villages and many hamlets but the present scenario is that only one village is controlling the said stadium that too by few people. It is, therefore, requested that kindly access the situation and hand over the ground to the department of Youth Services & Sports so that they can maintain its utility and will keep it open for all, not for a few people, or not for only one village.
6. **Irrigation Canals:-** In this whole Panchayat Halqa it was found that most of the Canals are unorganized and that seems to be one of the reasons that lead to water shortage. However, during the assessment of previous works, it was noted that one canal has been completed by 100% with the documental record but on the ground, only 5% of that irrigation canal has been completed.
7. **The approach road to Paddy fields/Fruit growing land:-** while assessing of whole Halqa and trying to access the farmers/fruit growers situation, it was noted that most of the land is without sufficient approach road to fields and therefore a huge economic burden is on farmers/fruit growers as they are forced to use huge manpower for the

collection of Paddy/Fruits. Keeping in view these circumstances, it is requested that such issues may kindly be addressed, e.g. Road from the Railway Track to Panchayat Ghar via the Land of Mohd. Akram Rather, Lt. Abdul Rehman Bhat & Abdul Gani Koka.

8. **Requirement of Bore wells:** - This area is as of now facing a lot of water crisis issues for all trio purposes like Irrigation, Drinking & Horticultural. In all these situations after consulting the concerned departments, Irrigation & Horticultural department can provide Bore Wells for public use with other necessary logistic support for that purpose during the visit few hot spots have been identified which can turn a great relief for the general public which are around 6 Bore-wells in requirement.
9. **Khidmat Centre:** - in this whole Panchayat Ghar, no Khidmat Centre is located so kindly take a look at that.
10. **Public Awareness:-** Most of the PRIs are without proper information about the working module of almost all departments, therefore, it is requested that kindly arrange two days workshop in this Halqa so that the general public as well as PRI will be aware of the government policies and will take benefit of various schemes.
11. **Mobile Network:-** In this whole Panchayat Halqa mostly in Villages Malikabad & Kewa mobile network is of low standard and we were even not able to upload data during the B2V due to low connectivity. Therefore it is requested that concerned corners may kindly be directed to improve it.
12. **Installation of Solar Water Pump & water reservoir Tank at Rather Mohalla** near the house of Abdul Samad Rather as this Mohalla is already blessed with a government-sanctioned water pump. The said water pump is at present in faded condition as it needs immediate care and repairment in which it is requested Installation of Solar Water Pump & Water reservoir tank may kindly be sanctioned and the concerned department should be directed to act on it because this Tube well will be at least able to cover 40 households.
13. **Coordination/ Lookafter Committee for Sports Ground:-** In this Halqa one sports ground is at present at Village Wanpora, But it is running without any management committee due to that reason many times this field turns out to be an area of conflict. Now keeping in view this issue, it is requested that one Management committee may kindly be framed and approved with Sarpanch & Concerned ZPEO be its head along with the concerned Panch so that the ground will be utilized in proper management.
14. **Power Transformer at Wagay Mohalla:** - In this Mohalla, they are already accessing one transformer but it seems that as per the representation of the public said transformer is not able to provide service smoothly due to overload. Therefore it is requested that necessary action may kindly be taken from the concerned area.
