
Proceeding of Mahila Sabha in terms of the agenda 8

The visit of the undersigned to the panchayat Dhar Mahanpur as visiting officer has been wonderful as well as eye opener. Although the area has been privy to me, but as a visiting officer, I came to know the basic problems being faced by the people living there, beside also I got the opportunity to acquaint with their culture/standard of living.

Though the village panchayat Dhar Mahanpur is located in the hilly area and has got the tremendous potential to attract the tourists, yet the panchayat has not developed so far. The village panchayat lacks the basic facilities and amenities which inter-alia includes:

- a) The interior and the exterior roads have not been macadamized or developed which puts a bad impression of the panchayat.
- b) The undersigned is witnessed of the three beautifully constructed buildings belongs to Tourism Department which are locked and not utilized for the purpose, reportedly due to some payment issue with the contractor which needs to be sorted in a time bound manner so that functioning of the Tourism Department does not hamper.
- c) Urgent and foremost need for establishment of primary health centre, so that first aid and the basic treatment can be given to the patients.
- d) It is also requires to educate the unemployed and educated youth about scores of Self Employment Generation schemes and motivate them to avail the benefits of the same.
- e) Youth club have been constituted but is not active, as such, we need to make them active at the earliest.
- f) There is no active involvement of panchayat body, there is a gap between the general public and panchayat body which needs to be shortened, so that the people can actively participate in panchayat activities.
- g) Apart from above, the Government middle school situated at Ker, needs to be upgraded for better education and sports activities as it has been the consistent demand of the public living in the area.
