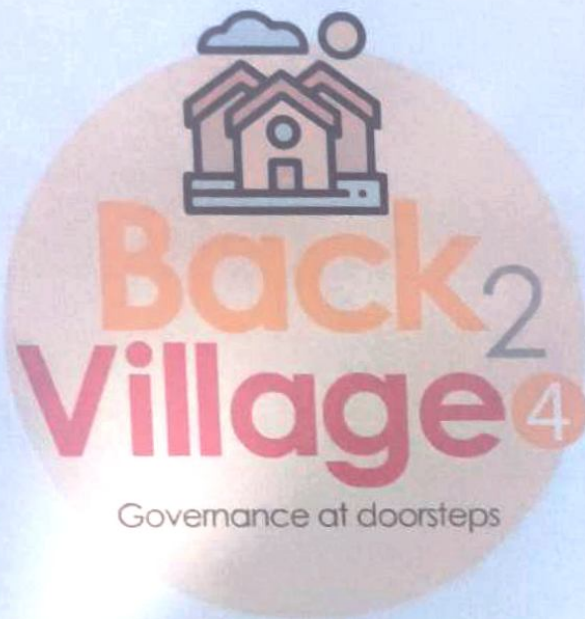

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on [www.jkpanchayat.in](http://www.jkpanchayat.in) portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

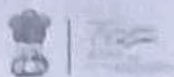

- 1- Medical Health centre should be recommended to facilitate the people of pvt. because whole journey for people is on foot and it is essential in the pvt.
- 2- Veterinary and sheep animal husbandary sub centres are also necessary which are not available in the pvt. people suffer more without this facility.
- 3- Three bridges for connectivity of shall pvt. with other panchayats are very essential
  - 1) Bridge between Rajnah and Shall on Lohai Nalla.
  - 2) Second bridge on Nalla between Kahr and Rusal.
  - 3) Third bridge on Bhini between Katoom and Brabber are essential to construct.
- 4- Strength of students in pvt. school shall is only eight where as it should be clubbed with other schools. None student comes to school. As disclosed in the meeting and also seen by us.
- 5- It is one of the most backward pvt. and pending payments under MGNREGA from 2016-17 need to make clear at earliest.
- 6- payment of pvt. Ghar need to be made in favour of payas singh s/o permi d/o Lower Thall which is Rs. 66000/- (Sixty six Thousand). He is a poor man and keeping for his payment at earliest.
- 7- Tourism is need to launch in the pvt. at tourist spot.
