## General Assessment of visiting officer

### (I) Major Complaints:-

- (1) About 50 files/cases under Forest Right Act have been submitted to RE & SO. Level Committee for final approval Decision, but still pending for last  $1\frac{1}{2}$  years.
- (2) Poor drinking water supply.
- (3) Despite no. of requests made to Ex. Eng. In (R&B) Dept for further extension of Road from T.V. Tower to Gugnal via Jalpaj, but no action has been taken by the Dept. However clearance of Forest Land seems to be pending.

(1) Hanging of electric wires on trees and wooden poles which is serious threat to life of human/animals.

### (2) Urgent public demands not yet Addressed.

- (1) Road from Hailia Pst to Prashwa via Gugnal (P&GS)
- (2) Const. of link road from (km 3rd) Good Ramban Road to High School Perahle B (PND)
- (3) Extension of Road from T.V. Tower to Gugnal via Jalpaj (PND)

### (II) Overall Assessment:- The Pst Hailia is totally Hilly and still very backward due to following reasons:-


- (1) Poor Road Connectivity, only one Road Good Ramban connects this Pst and the rest of the area is totally on foot.
- (2) Inadequate Drinking Water Supply due to non-implementation of SH Project proposed for this Pst.
- (3) Poor infrastructure of Electricity especially area of P&A.
- (4) No Primary Health Centre.
- (5) No HSS and separate High School for girls.
- (6) No ration distribution shed, Bank Centre etc.
- (7) Low performance/non implementation of ULLP for women.


