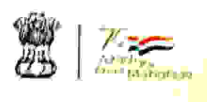

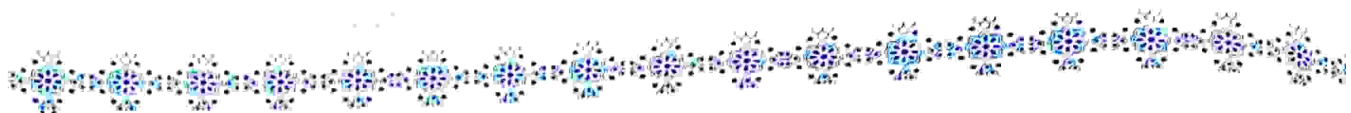

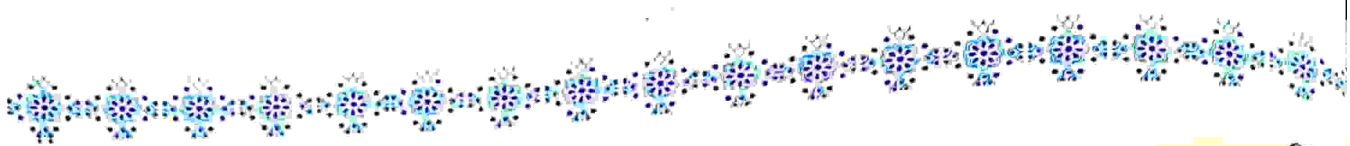

## NOTES

01. Construction of the <sup>road</sup> at CIP by R&B is not Satisfactory. Non-filling of sides on the road create inconvenience to traffic & people.

- Electricity infrastructure in the CIP is below standard. Wires are thin electricity poles are not provided by department and using wood poles are dangerous for people especially during winter.

- Two school buildings, one at UPS Jugtival and one at PS pandori are partially damaged, need replacement with new buildings. Fencing kitchen sheds are not available in these schools, Canal behind UPS is not maintained creating problems of water percolation in school built.
- Slide prone areas at CIP need proper attention from the concerned department to avert any future calamity."

02. Demand for road construction from main road to Gujarati Basti is urgently to be taken.

- Replacement of damaged school buildings of UPS Jugtival and PS pandori, fencing of both schools, construction of kitchen sheds are urgent.
- Renovation of electricity infrastructure at CIP.
- Forest tourist park at Traskodi Jugtival, Tourism hub at CIP
- Provision of street lights at CIP.
- Construction of bunds at slide prone areas. • Improvement of road at Ward No 7 near Ch. Nobi Khan.

03. The Visiting Officer along with Nodal Officer has visited Jugtival to receive feedback from people on the spot. Demands and complaints of the people are genuine that need proper consideration from the govt. Most of the demands raised by people in the past were raised by them in previous B2V programs but they were not taken up by the concerned departments.

Therefore, on behalf of CIP, I request and recommend that the demands and issues highlighted in the Booklet of B2V4 should be taken up on priority basis to ease the sufferings of CIP Jugtival.
